HB 154

Criminalize the administration of mRNA vaccines.

HB 71 - PASSED & BECOMES LAW ON 1/1/24

Makes it a felony to provide gender-affirming care to children.

HB 69

Prohibits vaccine passports or requirements for vaccines in order to enter public facilities or receive government services.

HB 155

Prohibits requiring any vaccine that is under an Emergency Use Authorization

HB 160

Person receiving any health service, including vaccinations, from a district health dept must first review and sign a risk/benefit statement.

DID YOU KNOW?

According to NIH, Adolescence is an important time for brain development.

The brain finishes developing and maturing in the midto-late 20s. The part of the brain behind the forehead, called the prefrontal cortex, is one of the last parts to mature. This area is responsible for skills like planning, prioritizing, and making good decisions.

SB 1005 - PASSED & SIGNED TO LAW

Parents must be provided with a copy of Idaho's policy allowing an opt out of immunization policies for day care.

HB 139

Prohibiting overt/pornographic sexual materials from being distributed to minors via the schools.

SB 1071

Prohibit instruction on human sexuality, sexual orientation, or gender identity prior to fifth arade.

SB 1029 - PASSED & BECOMES LAW ON 7/1/23

Prohibit a child protection investigation based on immunization status and a court shall not terminate a parent & child relationship based on a child's immunization status.

SB 1088

Prohibits private businesses from refusing service to people not vaccinated for COVID and prohibits requiring vaccination as a condition for employment.

HB 314 - VETOED

Prohibits certain materials from being promoted, given, or made available to a minor by a school or public library and to provide a cause of action.
